



Lauren Jones

Lauren Jones is the Assistant Director of Legal Affairs at the Anti-Defamation League. In that role, she provides specialized legal advice to ADL staff in regional offices around the country, files amicus briefs and submits testimony at the federal and state levels, and advocates for policies that further ADL's mission of securing justice and fair treatment for all. Her particular areas of focus include women's rights, immigration, voting, education equity, and bullying prevention. Prior to joining ADL, Lauren was a staff attorney at the Center for Family Representation in New York. She previously worked at the Brennan Center for Justice and was an Assistant Adjunct Professor in New York University's journalism department. She is a graduate of NYU and NYU School of Law.

Jeffrey Babbin

Jeffrey Babbin is a partner in Wiggin and Dana's Appellate and Complex Legal Issues Practice Group. From 2009-2012, he co-chaired the Connecticut Bar Association's Appellate Advocacy Section, and he is a Fellow of the American Academy of Appellate Lawyers. By appointment of Connecticut's Chief Justice, he also serves on the Connecticut Advisory Committee on Appellate Rules. Jeff has handled over a hundred appeals of trial court and agency decisions before federal and state courts nationally. He has also been lead counsel for the Anti-Defamation League on two amicus briefs filed in the Supreme Court, involving the activities of an after-school evangelical Christian club in a public elementary school and the display of the Ten Commandments in a courthouse and on the grounds of a state capitol. Jeff is a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania and Stanford Law School.
